- **Arkansas Inland Maritime Museum** (120 Riverfront Park Dr., North Little Rock 72114) – \$2 admission. Authentic Naval artifacts and hear about the USS *Razorback* submarine and the tugboat *Hoga*, known for her heroic efforts at Pearl Harbor. [www.aimmuseum.org](http://www.aimmuseum.org) – indoors
- **Burns Park** (1 Eldor Johnson Dr., North Little Rock 72116) – free, outdoor playgrounds throughout the park for all ages. Includes accessible playground, trails and dog park.
- **Funland Amusement Park** (25 Funland Dr., North Little Rock 72116) – weather permitting, open Friday–Sunday. Ferris wheel, carousel, bungee jump and more for young children, \$12 unlimited one-day rides.
- **Museum of Discovery** (500 President Clinton Ave., Little Rock 72201) – fun for all ages to experience science. \$2 admission on Sept. 6. [www.museumofdiscovery.org](http://www.museumofdiscovery.org) – indoors
- **William F. - **St. Joseph Center of Arkansas** (6800 Camp Robinson Rd., North Little Rock) – farm stand Saturdays 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. Browse local products and see the goats, sheep, and cows. Free.
- **Trail of Tears/Arkansas River Trail** (120 Riverfront Park Dr., North Little Rock, AR 72114) – bike or walk the beautiful trail next to the Arkansas River. Free.
- **The Old Mill** (3800 Lakeshore Dr., North Little Rock 72116) – free, public park with a replica 1800s grist-mill and original sculptures by Mexican artist Dionicio Rodriguez. Open daily.
